RE: Addendum #3 - Bid No. AB 47-24 – Sludge Loading, Hauling and Disposal

To All Potential Bidders:

The following addendum shall apply to the Bid Specifications for Bid No. AB 47-24 “Sludge Loading, Hauling and Disposal.” **With this addendum, the bid due date has been extended to December 18 at 10:00 AM at the Village Clerk of the Village of Sauget.**

1. The following shall replace Item 11 Basis of Payment in the Bid Specifications:

11. Basis of Payment

Invoices for the sludge loading and hauling for disposal shall be calculated based on the unit price per hour for sludge hauled as indicated on the bid form. The cost per hour hauled will start from the time that the driver enters the American Bottoms facility to pick up a load to the time that load is offloaded at the specified landfill (empty tare weight time. The card entrance reader at the American Bottoms gate and landfill scale weight tickets will be used to verify the hours per load hauled. A maximum of 2 hours per haul time per load is what shall be charged unless there are proven delays at the loading and offloading locations not caused by the contractor.

The quantity of dewatered sludge hauled and disposed shall be certified based on the daily weight tickets and load receipts from the disposal site. The contractor shall submit on routine basis copies of weight tickets and load receipts reflecting the net weight of dewatered sludge hauled and disposed per load. The tickets/receipts shall be delivered to the Operations Coordinator no more than one week following disposal of the dewatered sludge. Failure to comply is cause for termination. The net weight shall be determined from the weight of the load upon delivery to the disposal site less the empty weight on departure from the disposal site. If the disposal site does not have a licensed scale, a mutually agreeable licensed scale shall be selected.

The unit cost per hour hauled of dewatered sludge shall include all costs and charges for loading and hauling of the dewatered sludge. The cost of permits for hauling and disposal, container charges, scale fees and related charges and

other miscellaneous fees shall be included in the unit price per hour of dewatered sludge hauled and disposed. No fuel surcharges shall be added to the unit costs.

The contractor shall submit invoices for the services performed to the Operations Coordinator on a monthly basis. Payment shall be made within thirty days of receipt of an approved invoice and cost certification.
